The selection of Chaskin to lead the agency came after an extensive regional search led by former JCA President Adam Frisch and a diverse representation of JCA board members.

Prior to Adam's work at JCCs, he had a successful career as a college basketball coach. Adam is a 1992 graduate of The University of Michigan with a Bachelor of Science in Industrial and Operations Engineering. Adam has been happily married to Regina Chaskin for 25 years and has two sons Grant, 22, and Noah, 20.
