REFUGEE SOCCER LEAGUE ENTERS THIRD SEASON

JACKSONVILLE, Florida – All Nations Soccer League (ANSL), Jacksonville’s first refugee soccer league, is kicking off its third season on Saturday, February 2. Since its launch in March 2017, ANSL has grown to 12 teams totaling 240 players from 50 nations.

The league was founded by former Jacksonville Armada FC player Josh Kimball. Strengthened by a network of local churches, agencies, and businesses, ANSL leaders seek to restore, unify, and empower refugees. The league’s key partner, World Relief, is the organization responsible for the resettlement of a majority of ANSL competitors.

Saturday, ANSL players, family, and friends came together for the initial exhibition game at Jacksonville University. Last season’s champion FC Mike led 2-0 against incoming team FC Phins.

ANSL invites the Jacksonville community to the second preseason match this Saturday, January 19 at Earl Johnson Park. Former contender FC Citadel and newcomer Oway FC will face off at 1 p.m.
