Our papers are audited and staffed by local reporters. Nine of the publications are sold by subscription and distributed by mail, carrier or at a newsstand.

### WHO WE REACH\*

RING newspapers reach over 130,000 unique households in Rhode Island and Southeastern Massachusetts offering full coverage of the Providence DMA. The vast majority of our readers are homeowners. They are committed to their communities. They are educated, active participants in their towns and cities.

- 62% of our subscribers have household incomes over \$75,000, significantly higher than general market demographics
