

RESOLUTION NO. 18-15
CITY OF KILGORE, TEXAS
MASTER FEE SCHEDULE
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2018

WHEREAS, the City of Kilgore has the authority to set rates, fees, charges, deposits, etc., charged for city services; and

WHEREAS, Kilgore's previous fee schedule for municipal services was codified throughout all ordinances that contained a specified fee;

WHEREAS, the Kilgore City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1558 on July 24, 2012, amending Appendix B: Fee Schedule to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Kilgore, thereby allowing for the adoption by resolution of a master fee schedule which would remove specific fees from individual city ordinances, thus allowing for greater flexibility in the future for setting fees as the need arises; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Kilgore, Texas hereby establishes the following as the Master Fee Schedule pursuant to Ordinance No. 1558 to be enforced until such time as the City Council deems it necessary to amend this Master Fee Schedule.

WATER AND SEWER FEES

(a) **WATER SERVICE RATES INSIDE CITY**

(1) Residential use. The monthly rates or charges for water service furnished by the city's waterworks system for residential use shall be as follows:

- (A) ~~\$13.64~~ **\$14.32** customer service charge.
- (B) ~~\$3.91~~ **\$4.11** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption up to 10,000 gallons.
- (C) ~~\$4.50~~ **\$4.73** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption between 10,001 to 40,000.
- (D) ~~\$5.16~~ **\$5.42** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption 40,001 to 250,000 gallons
- (E) ~~\$5.89~~ **\$6.18** per 1,000 gallons over 250,000 gallons

Qualifying senior citizens, age 65 and over, will be eligible for a ~~\$2.50~~ **\$5.00** discount off the customer service charge.

(2) Commercial use. The monthly rates or charges for water service furnished by the city's waterworks system for commercial use shall be as follows:

- (A) ~~\$13.64~~ **\$14.32** customer service charge.
- (B) ~~\$4.44~~ **\$4.66** per thousand gallons for all consumption up to 10,000 gallons.
- (C) ~~\$5.96~~ **\$6.26** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption from 10,001 to 250,000 gallons.
- (D) ~~\$7.02~~ **\$7.37** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption from 250,001 to 999,999 gallons
- (E) ~~\$8.08~~ **\$8.48** per thousand gallons for all consumption over 1,000,000 gallons.

(3) It is the intent of this section that the city be paid for service for each consumer according to the above rates whether or not they are on a separate meter, and for service to each meter, although connected to a line or lines of a single customer. Where more than one consumer is connected to one line or one meter, the minimum rate will be charged for each consumer connected thereto. The amount to be paid to the city shall be the above customer service charge multiplied by the number of customers, plus the amount due for all usage per customer according to the above-listed schedule. For multiple meters connected to a line or lines of a single consumer, the amount to be paid the city shall be the above minimum charge per meter multiplied by the number of meters, plus the amount due for all usage per meter, according to the above-listed schedule.

(b) **WATER SERVICE RATES OUTSIDE CITY**

(1) Residential use. The monthly rates or charges for water service furnished by the city's waterworks system for residential use shall be as follows:

- (A) ~~\$27.28~~ **\$28.64** customer service charge.
- (B) ~~\$8.14~~ **\$8.21** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption up to 10,000 gallons.
- (C) ~~\$8.94~~ **\$9.45** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption from 10,001 to 40,000 gallons.
- (D) ~~\$10.33~~ **\$10.84** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption from 40,001 to 250,000 gallons.
- (E) ~~\$11.77~~ **\$12.37** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption over 250,000 gallons

Qualifying senior citizens, age 65 and over, will be eligible for a ~~\$2.50~~ **\$5.00** discount off the customer service charge.

(2) Commercial use. The monthly rates or charges for water service furnished by the city's waterworks system for commercial use shall be as follows:

- (A) ~~\$27.28~~ **\$28.64** customer service charge.
- (B) ~~\$8.87~~ **\$9.32** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption up to 10,000 gallons.
- (C) ~~\$11.91~~ **\$12.52** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption from 10,001 to 250,000 gallons.
- (D) ~~\$14.03~~ **\$14.74** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption from 250,001 to 999,999 gallons
- (E) ~~\$16.14~~ **\$16.97** per 1,000 gallons for all consumption over 1,000,000 gallons.

(3) It is the intent of this section that the city be paid for service for each consumer according to the above rates whether or not they are on a separate meter, and for service to each meter, although connected to a line or lines of a single customer. Where more than one consumer is connected to one line or one meter, the minimum rate will be charged for each consumer connected thereto. The amount to be paid to the city shall be the above water customer service charge multiplied by the number of customers, plus the amount due for all usage per customer according to the above-listed schedule. For multiple meters connected to a line or lines of a single consumer, the amount to be paid the city shall be the above minimum charge per meter multiplied by the number of meters, plus the amount due for all usage per meter, according to the above-listed schedule.

(c) Water corporation rates. Monthly rates or charges for water furnished to water corporations outside the city limits are established by contract with each water corporation based on its demand on the system.

(d) Temporary water rates.

- ~~(1) \$15.75 for 10 days for up to 2,000 gallons + per gallon charges for consumption greater than 2,000 gallons~~
- ~~(2) \$31.50 for 20 days for up to 4,000 gallons + per gallon charges for consumption greater than 4,000 gallons~~

~~No more than 40 days of temporary water service will be granted unless approved by the City Manager.~~

\$30.00 for up to 30 days + per-gallon charges for consumption.

No more than 30 days of temporary water service will be granted unless approved by the City Manager.

(e) Bulk water rates.

- (1) ~~\$23.82 per bobtail load up to 2,939 gallons~~
- (2) ~~\$52.92 per transport load between 2,940 gallons and 5,500 gallons~~

\$10.00 per 1,000 gallons, rounded up to nearest 1,000 gallon.

(f) Community and Recreational Facility Water Rates.

Some city and community common areas, as well as recreational and cemetery facilities, will be charged \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons. Eligibility for this rate will be determined by the City Manager.

SEWER SERVICE RATES

(a) Each person using the sewer services of the city, within the city limits, shall pay a sewer customer service charge of ~~\$11.53~~ **\$12.11** per month per residential, commercial and industrial user. A charge of ~~\$4.90~~ **\$5.15** per 1,000 gallons of metered water consumption will be charged as follows. (1987 Code, sec. 7.5-1)

(b) Sewer charges for residential users will be based upon the average of the three lowest **consecutive** months of water consumption by such user over a twelve-month period, beginning with the first day of March and ending with the last day of February. The first residential billing of May of each year will reflect the new or revised rates. For new residential accounts having no consumption history, the sewer charge will be based on the three lowest months' average consumption of all residential water service accounts beginning with the first day of March and ending with the last day of February until the account has established a twelve-month consumption history. The first residential billing of May of each year will reflect the new or revised rates. (Ordinance 1366, sec. 1, adopted 1/8/08)

(c) Commercial and industrial users will be charged based on actual water consumption during each month.

(d) All users in areas outside the city limits will be charged a rate double the inside city rates. For example, residential sewer base rate outside the city limits will be ~~\$23.06~~ **\$24.21**. A charge of ~~\$9.79~~ **\$10.29** per 1,000 gallons of metered water consumption will be charged as follows. (1987 Code, sec. 7.5-1)

(e) Qualifying senior citizens, age 65 and over, will be eligible for a ~~\$2.50~~ **\$5.00** discount off the customer service charge (residential only).

MOTELS WITHIN CITY

(a) Water service rates. The monthly rates or charges for water service furnished inside the city by the city's waterworks system for motel use shall be at the minimum commercial rate figured at eighty (80) percent occupancy.

(b) Sewer service rates. Sewer charges for motels will be charged the same as residential/commercial rates figured at eighty (80) percent occupancy.

CONNECTIONS AND TRANSFERS

(a) New account (residential or commercial): \$50.00 nonrefundable fee.

(b) Transfer fee for existing accounts: \$25.00.

(c) Water and sewer tap fees: ~~Does not include street repair or road bore if needed.~~ These are billed at actual cost for time and materials. Labor charges will be made using prevailing wage rates in the area. Fifty (50) percent of the initial estimate is due prior to construction. Remaining actual costs will be due prior to establishing services. Unpaid sewer taps will result in water shutoff.

(a) Service fee of eighty-seven cents (\$0.87) per month is assessed against each customer and subscriber within the city limits of any and all telephone retail service providers.

(b) Any and all telephone retail service providers are authorized to collect such fee on behalf of the city by inclusion of such amount on its monthly customer billing.

TRAFFIC FEES

(a) Financial responsibility verification form: \$5.00.

(b) Impoundment of illegally parked vehicles: \$2.00 together with all other costs of removal and storage that may have accrued thereon.

OIL AND GAS WELL FEES

(a) Permit for drilling oil or gas well: \$500.00.

(b) Processing fee for refusal or withdrawal of drilling permit: \$200.00.

(c) Permit for re-drilling oil or gas well: \$500.00.

(d) Processing fee for refusal or withdrawal of re-drilling permit: \$200.00.

(e) Plugging oil or gas well permit: \$25.00.

(f) Permit for construction, moving or replacement of petroleum tanks: \$25.00.

(Ordinance 1415 adopted 1/27/09)

1. Fire Alarm Permit: \$100.00

2. Fire Sprinklers Permit: \$100.00

3. Fire Suppression Systems: \$60.00 (systems include paint booths, kitchen hood systems, and underground fire mains)

4. Underground and above-ground storage tank installation: \$60.00 per tank

5. Underground and above-ground tank removal: \$60.00 per tank

6. First and second re-inspection: No Charge

7. Third inspection: \$75.00

8. Fourth inspection: \$100.00

9. After-hours inspection: \$75.00 per hour (2-hour minimum)

10. Mandatory staff/facility training: No Charge

11. Day care facilities: \$50.00 per facility

12. Hospitals inspections: \$100.00

13. Mental Health/M.H.M.R. Facility: \$100.00
14. Nursing Home/Assisted Living Facility: \$100.00
15. Following Day Care facilities for Foster Home (any mandated inspection not otherwise classified): \$50.00
16. Burn Permit: \$50.00 per day
17. Operational permits fees under section 105.6 of the International Fire Code: No Charge
18. False alarm at the same site for subsequent false alarms fee: If the engine is dispatched and cancelled en route, it is not chargeable. Five free chargeable fire alarms allowed per calendar year. Begin charging on 6th and subsequent false alarms during the calendar year: \$75.00
19. Fire flow verification fee for hydrants from sprinkler companies: \$100.00
20. Permit for public fireworks display: \$50.00
21. Permit for fireworks retail sales: \$50.00
22. Home/Rental fire safety inspection: No Charge
23. Exhibit/Trade Show Permit: \$50.00
24. Fire Report: \$10.00

COURT FEES

Warrant Fee

A fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be charged for the issuance and service of a warrant of arrest, which fee, as an expense, shall be paid to the city treasury for the use and benefit of the city.

FTA Program Fee

Utilizing the Failure to Appear Program (FTA) offered by the Driver License Division under Transportation Code Chapter 706, the Municipal Court shall collect the statutorily required \$30.00 administrative fee as set forth by the Texas Department of Public Safety.

Fee for Jury Trial

Three dollars (\$3.00) shall be charged of any defendant requesting a jury trial.

Jury Pay

Each person serving as a juror in any case tried in the municipal court of the city shall be paid for his services at the rate of seven dollars (\$7.00) per day.

State law reference – Jury pay and expenses for jurors, Tex. Code Crim. Proc. art. 104.001.

Security Fee

(a) The judge and any associate judge of the municipal court of the city, upon the conviction of any person for a misdemeanor offense in municipal court, is authorized to collect (in addition to any and all other fines, court costs, and fees) a security fee of three dollars (\$3.00) as a cost of court from the defendant.

(b) For the purposes of this section a person is considered to be convicted if:

- (1) A sentence is imposed on the person;
- (2) The person receives community supervision, including deferred adjudication; or
- (3) The court defers final disposition of the person’s case.

Technology Fee

The fee shall be in the amount of \$4.00.
