Huron to host 24th Annual Ringneck Festival

Huron is ever-eager to celebrate the state bird, so much so that it named our festival for it. The Ringneck Festival is celebrating the 24th year Nov. 4-6. This competition event is hosted by the Huron Chamber and Visitors Bureau and began with the 6-man competitive hunt in 1997 known as the Ringneck Festival and expanded to include a Bird Dog Challenge the two days prior.

The Bird Dog Challenge on Thursday and Friday, acts as a pre-event to the festival's main event. Teams of two hunters and one dog between them have 15 minutes to shoot up to five birds

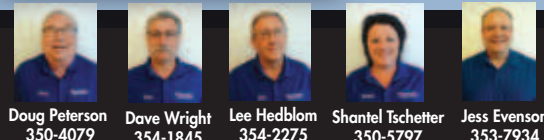
The Bird Dog challenge is set up on one property with two fields consisting of 3-5 acres per field. The birds are planted right before the hunters go out into the field. Hunters are placed in a trailer and do not see where the birds are placed.

Friday night of the festival hosts a "Meet the Landowner" banquet, and calcutta auction for the main event, in which individuals may bid on and purchase Saturday's teams, which then gets thrown into one combined pot. Those individuals who have suc-

cessfully purchased teams will receive payout based on how their team places, paying approximately \$8,000 to \$12,000 for first place, chairman Kent Shelton said and there is a payout for teams that place 1st thru 5th.

After a rules meeting and provided breakfast Saturday morning, teams of six and unlimited dogs head out to private land--donated to use for the event by local landowners--to shoot a limit of 18 birds from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. Two dogs are allowed in the field hunting with the 6 person team and can be switched out periodically. At the Saturday evening Awards Banquet, the team that returns with the most birds in hand and the most shells remaining is deemed the winner, and whoever bought that teams in the calcutta goes home with their wallet heavier. Each member of the first- and second-place teams and their landowner receive guns sponsored by the Huron Chamber and Visitors Bureau and its many sponsors. The third-place team does not go home empty handed, they each receive \$500 gift cards.

Bird Dog Challenge kicks off Ringneck Festival

Kicking off the annual Ringneck Festival is the Bird Dog Challenge Nov. 4-5.

The Huron Chamber and Visitors Bureau has hosted this exhibition testing and showcasing the skills of dogs and hunters since 2002 taking one year off in 2020 due to the COVID pandemic.

The Bird Dog Challenge has grown since its inception and the dogs and hunters competing have come all over the United States.

Each Bird Dog team is made up of two hunters and one dog.

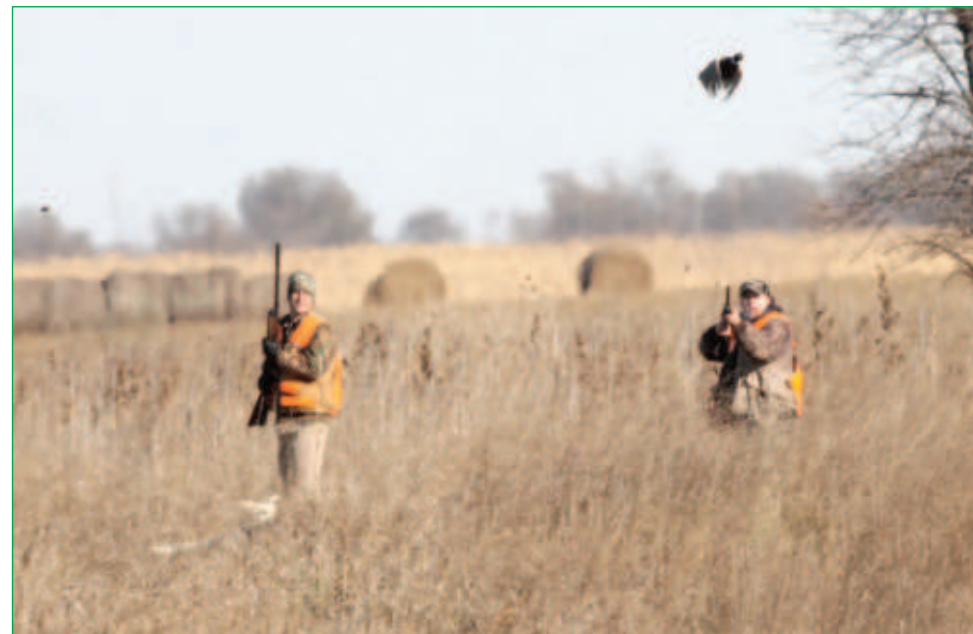
Each hunter has five shells and 15 minutes to harvest birds. Points

are awarded based on birds harvested, full, partial and normal retrieves, shots not taken and every second remaining on the clock.

The Bird Dog Challenge registration is \$175 per team and is due by Oct. 20.

Cash prizes are awarded for contestants placing first to fifth place.

RINGNECK:

Teams travel from all over the country and often many faces are seen year after year. The event usually brings in three or four new teams each year, and depending on land availability, some teams may get turned away. The deadline for teams to register for the Ringneck Festival each year is Aug. 31. Applications are available online at www.hunthuronsd.com/ringneck-festival-bird-dog-challenge. The event began when Tom Hawley, moved to Huron to work as editor for the Huron Daily Plainsman. He said that there should be a hunting competition similar to goose hunts he had participated in. So began the Ringneck Festival.

"With the event being in its 24th year, the fun part is getting to see the hunters who return year after year," said Laurie Shelton, President & CEO of the Huron Chamber & Visitors Bureau. "It's about the camaraderie and friendships that have built over these years. That's what the sport of hunting is all about."

The Ringneck Festival strives to give back to their competitors and volunteers in two ways: to youth hunting programs and a scholarship program.

Bob Strassman, one of their frequent hunters, donated a shotgun in 2005, the year after his daughter Stephanie died in a car accident while he was at the Ringneck Festival. The

Strassman Fund donates funds every year to youth hunting programs, such as disabled youth hunts, 4-H hunting programs, and Pheasants Forever youth programs.

A scholarship fund was also established for volunteers or the children of volunteers and landowners to receive funds toward their college education.

"Without the volunteers who help us, this event simply could not happen, so we encourage them or their kids to apply for the scholarship," Laurie said. "It's an incentive and reward for volunteers to continue to be volunteers so they can apply for those funds."

The scholarship fund was born from the auctioning of a donated Ringneck Festival & Bird Dog Challenge Banner and then one of the volunteers donated a gun to be auctioned off that same night. It just kept snowballing into more than expected for the first year.

"Now we ask our teams to provide a silent auction item so that we can continue to provide scholarships," Shelton said.

The "RLB Hall of Fame" is another way that the Ringneck Festival committee acknowledges the teams, volunteers and sponsors that help contribute to the success of the event.

"The Ringneck Festival has grown tremendously over the years and is an event that we are very proud to host and to showcase our Huron hospitality" said Shelton.

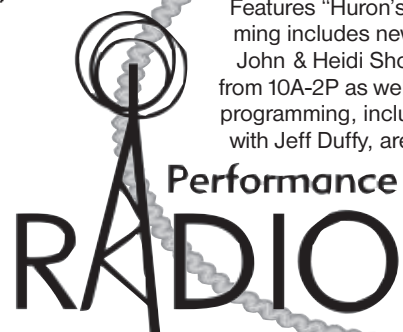

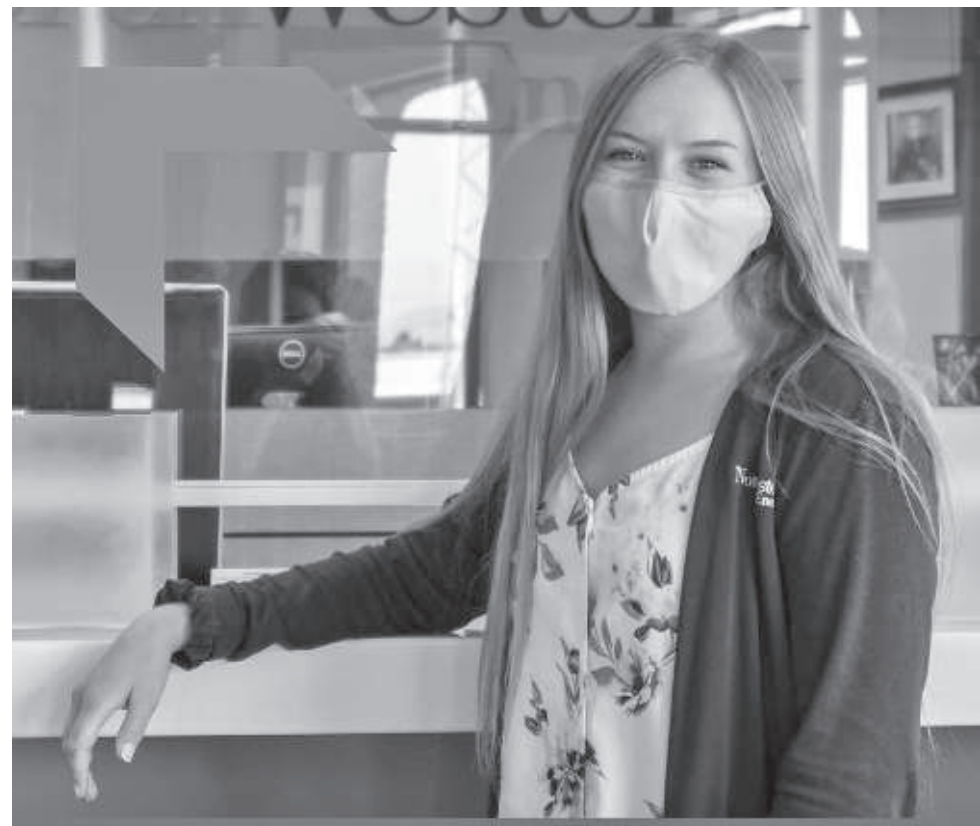
