Key Messages

- Severe storms expected tonight south of I-80
- Another round of storms Sunday, low confidence in severe threat
- Have a weather source that can wake you up...keep your Weather Radio handy!

Important Changes from Weekend Outlook Issued This Morning

- Areas south of Interstate 80 upgraded to Enhanced Risk of severe storms tonight
- A few storms could have very large hail, bigger than golf balls

Next Scheduled Briefing

- None unless there are significant changes to the forecast through the weekend



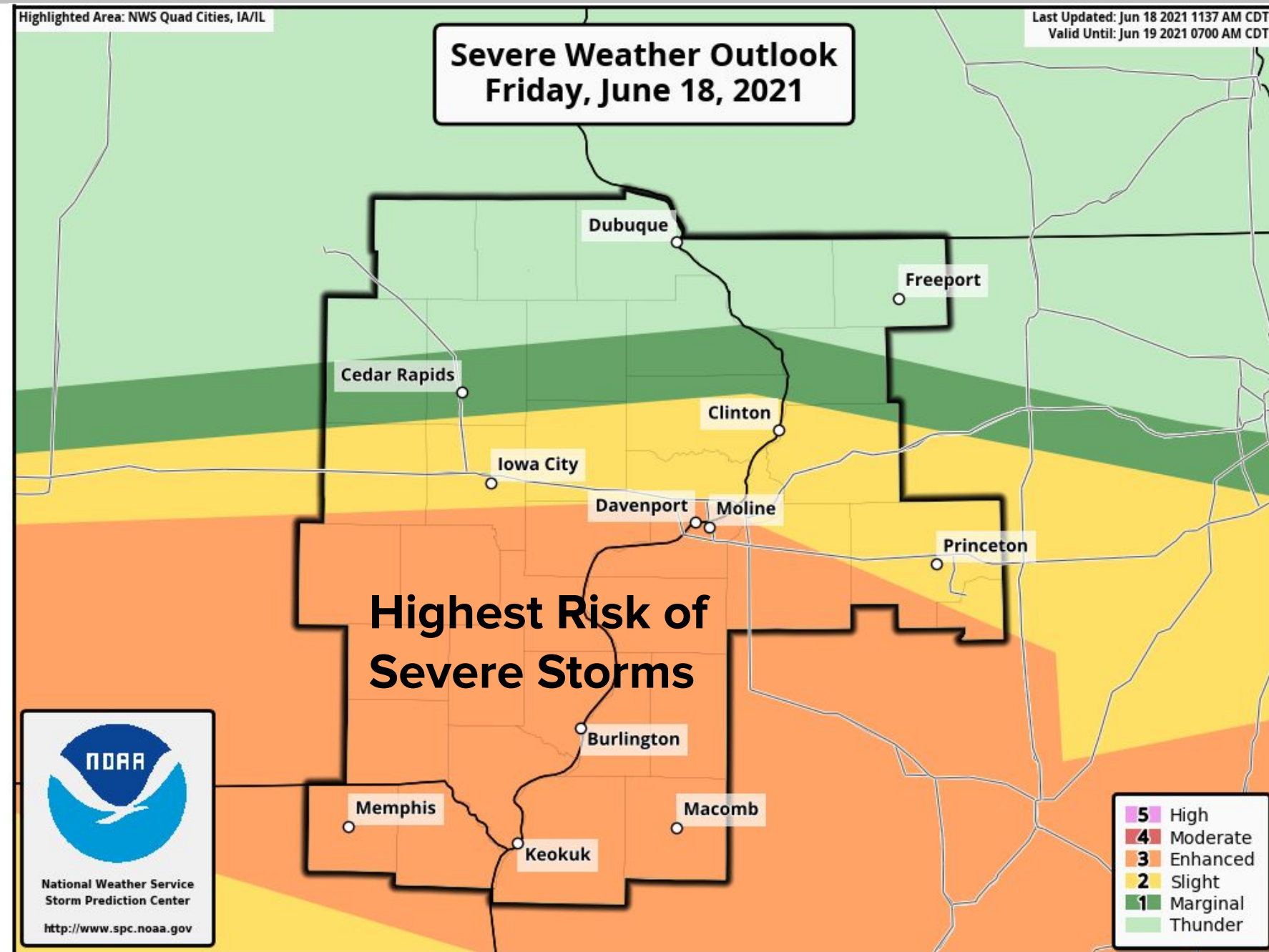
Severe Storms Expected Tonight

June 18, 2021

Main threat area is south of Interstate 80

Overview

- Main hazards are very large hail, damaging winds, and an isolated tornado
- Main risk between 8 pm and 3 am Saturday
- Isolated 2-3 inch rainfall amounts, but low risk of flash flooding



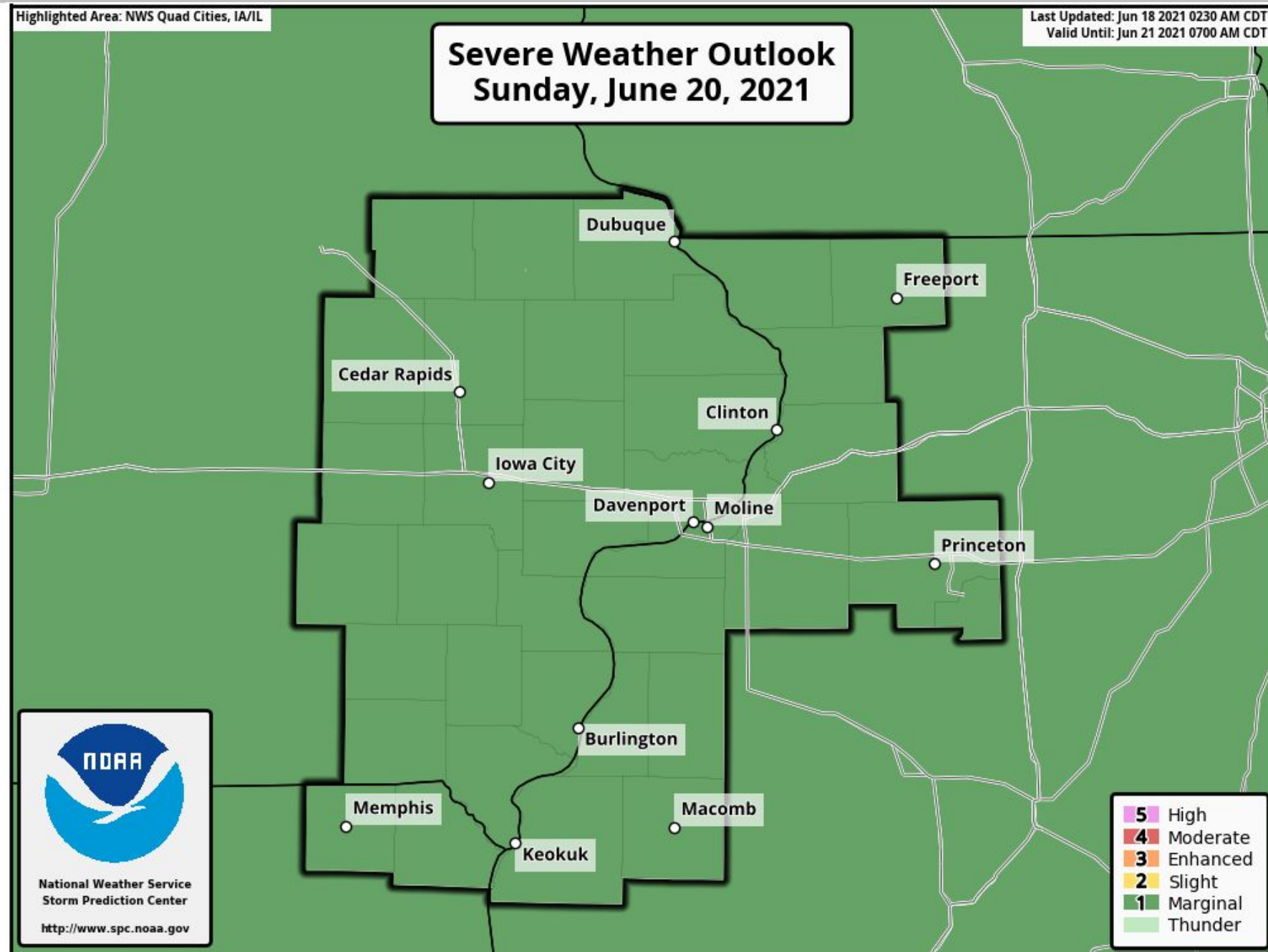


Severe Storm Potential Sunday

Overview

- ➔ Currently a low risk of damaging winds and large hail area-wide
- ➔ Main risk between 3 pm and Midnight
- ➔ Monitoring potential for higher threat and coverage of storms

ENHANCED RISK

Numerous severe storms possible.

Some longer lived severe storms -- a few intense storms possible.

Have multiple ways to get NWS warnings and seek shelter immediately when warnings are issued for your location.

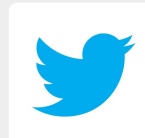
