We have to fit both practices in the one hour that we have to practice. We're really excited. Game day is going to be a lot of fun."

This will be Paige Orr's first year of high school cheerleading.

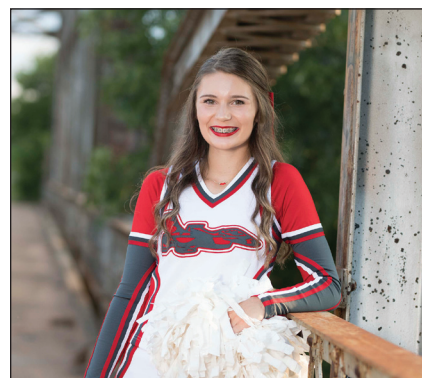

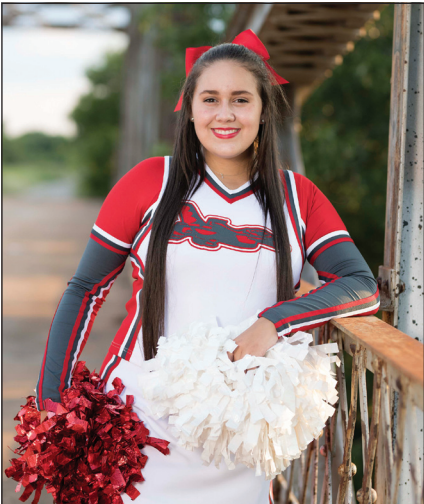
