Selecting the RIGHT **Roofing Contractor**

If a company has a MHIC number, you can rest assured that this company has passed a Maryland licensing test that proves that the company is in good financial standing, has all insurances and is in good credit standing. Also, this a critical question and differentiator to ask: "Do all of your salespeople have a MHIC Maryland sales license?" A company with a MHIC license and licensed salespeople provides a great way to differentiate a quality company from just another roofing company. It shows company values, commitment, quality and superior professionalism.

Also ask about the company's warranty offers — for both materials and workmanship. All these things, when combined, means that you are dealing with a quality roofing contractor, with proper training, proven knowledge and competence, along with being a responsible



company as viewed by the state of Maryland. Another differentiator is to note if the roofing company invests back into its community. Ask if the company and owners are a Greater Severna Park and Arnold Chamber of Commerce member. Do they support various causes in the community? A company that values and invests in the community, and is a chamber of commerce member, shows key signs of being a quality company that is part of the community fabric.

Second, check that the company has the highest levels of manufacturer's certifications, which proves that the roofing company is dedicated to and invests in the training and education, at a high level, for its team, ensuring that they are trained in all the latest installation techniques of various roofing materials.

Third, check Google reviews. Compare these reviews

against all companies that you are considering for your roofing job. Do they have a lot of reviews or just a few? What is their Google reviews rating? Look for companies that have a 4.9 to 5 review rating. Also, look for a company that has multiple reviews to check — not just a few. This will let you know about the way the company does business and will give you a level of confidence in how the company performs and how customers perceive the work they have done for many installations. This is critical in your roofing contractor search.

Turning to roof inspection, we want to address several things that are very important for you to know about roof inspections. How often should you have your roof inspected? How do you know if you have any roof damage? Is a roof inspection necessary if you just had a new roof installed? Let's review. First, we all go to the dentist every six months, and we also have annual health appointments to ensure we are in good physical health. Should there be any issues, a plan is made to address them. The same applies to your home's roof. It is a critical element of your home and needs attention too.

Look at it this way: either you have had a roof inspection or you have not. Chances are that you have not. If you haven't had a roof inspection, we recommend that you call and schedule one with a qualified local roofing company. There should be no charge. The company will







Critical Planning In A Critical Area

hether planning a large addition, building a pool, adding a garage, installing a shed or outbuilding, creating sidewalks or patios, or doing smaller projects – tree removal, brush cleanups or rerouting gutters and French drains – an amount of planning can be critical to reach the finish line on time.

A piece of that preparation puzzle is, obviously, what you want to build, but just as important, where? We have all seen and heard the commercials, "Call before you dig" from Miss Utility and the 311 phone services, but there can be more to it than just electric lines, plumbing and gas lines. Does your property/project exist within a Critical Area?



What is a Critical Area?

According to the Anne Arundel County Department of Planning and Zoning, Critical Area is located 1,000 feet landward from mean high tide or the edge of tidal wetlands, as designated on the state tidal wetland maps, and all waters of and lands under the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries.

Seems like most of Anne Arundel County falls within this area! What can this mean for your project?

The following activities must have approval through the forestry section outlined by

the Anne Arundel County Department of Inspections and Permits:

- Clearing or grading, including cutting or pruning of existing vegetation (except for routine grass cutting and maintenance of existing garden and landscaped areas)
- Disturbance of steep slopes
- Construction, alteration or relocation of a structure or lot coverage
- Installation of stormwater management system

In short, the intent of the Critical Area stipulations is to preserve the water quality of the Chesapeake Bay as well as the wildlife habitat along the shoreline. Water runoff and retention are other key factors. For every square foot of impervious material, the rainwater and groundwater are then displaced from their normal path, as water finds a path of least resistance.

In a small yard, this may mean the water that is now running down the new shed roof creates a gully in your yard to eventually create erosion.



the floods of downtown Ellicott City, those were caused by overdevelopment uphill and in surrounding areas. Water finds a way, overflowing the river, flooding downtown.

Depending on the project, navigating this process can be easier than it seems. The forestry section of Inspections and Permits for Anne Arundel County may advise to shift, downsize or move your project in tandem with planting x number of native trees, bushes or shrubs to help mitigate and soak up the water retention/runoff issues.

In many instances, there is an option to pay a fee so that the forestry section may take your money to use elsewhere to mitigate issues throughout local Critical Areas.

It can seem difficult enough to initiate and execute a project without thinking of all the outside checks and balances.

To ask for approval just to put down a flagstone paver patio or cut down some brush on your steep sloped backyard, at face value, does seem like overkill. On the other side, having practices and commissions in place to keep Anne Arundel County a beautiful, safe, clean environment for people, animals and vegetation is worth celebrating and encouraging.

ARE MOSQUITOES ATTRACTED TO CARBON DIOXIDE?

Mosquitoes are drawn to carbon dioxide because it signals to them that there is an animal with blood nearby. They can sense your carbon dioxide output from up to 100 feet away! Mosquitoes have receptor cells on their antennae and legs that sense carbon dioxide and send a signal to their brain indicating they're near a potential host.

This is why it may seem like mosquitoes are attracted to your breath and extra attracted to you if you're breathing heavily. However, your natural metabolic rate also determines your carbon dioxide output.

Apart from your breath and blood type, external factors can also attract mosquitoes. Let's get into those!

When selecting the contractor for your property, ask questions to ensure that the contractor is qualified to propose the proper solutions for your circumstance and also pay close attention to project details that can ultimately go a long way.

On The Job

When scheduling with a contractor to have your drive-way sealed, it's important the contractor ensures they will seal any cracks prior to application of any sealers. In concrete pavement, the crack needs to be first chased out to open it up for filler products to best adhere inside the crack, thus stopping water from further intruding. Then, how much time does the contractor commit to preparing the surface? Concrete or as-

phalt needs to be completely clean, either prepared by pressure washing or cleaning thoroughly with steel brooms, blowers, etc.

Ask your potential contractor how they will apply their products near your delicate surfaces like garage doors, stone and walkways. Spray applications can be messy: ultimately you may want to side with a contractor who cuts your edges in carefully by hand. When there is a slight chance of rain (we all know how unpredictable the summertime Maryland forecasts can be), it's wise to hang protective plastic across delicate surfaces to protect against splashing in the event of a flash storm. Once the job is completed, the work area should be cordoned off with clearly noticeable caution tape (or comparable barricade) for the specified amount of time to prevent any accidental foot or vehicle traffic while products are still drying.
